Global Social Justice Education in Geography

Geography is a structured way of exploring and understanding the natural and man made features of our world. It is rich ground for global social justice education through the key concepts of place, space, environment, interconnection, sustainability, scale and change. The whole person and the context of a global society are critical elements of education, deeply embedded in the Australian Geography curriculum.

The Australian Geography curriculum invites teachers and students to investigate the state of the world and our relationships and responsibilities within it. Poverty is created by the actions of people. This means it can be eradicated – it's not a question of *if*, but *when*. But for this to happen, we must all work together towards the creation of a more just world.

Effective aid and community development work are central to the fight against poverty and inequality. There are so many global issues that affect marginalised and vulnerable people where OUR voice can really make a difference. The Australian Geography curriculum has been designed with a view for equipping students with the cross disciplinary understandings to envision and work towards a socially just and sustainable future.

Our geography resources provide you with meaningful opportunities to explore students' interconnectedness with their world, develop lifelong understanding and critical thinking, and nurture curiosity and compassion. Everything Caritas Australia offers will help you enhance your pupils' learning, while at the same time addressing each of the cross- curriculum priorities and several of the general capabilities.

We have updated our Geography resources with the associated Geography links. While the new curriculum is structured year level specific, many of these resources can be adapted and used across primary school year levels. The Category title includes Geography curriculum terms. The specific links aim to assist you with planning, assessment and integrated inquiry teaching.
